

## WOLFGANG VOGEL MEMORIAL AWARD APPLICANT GUIDELINES

The Wolfgang Vogel Memorial Award is intended to recognize meritorious Postdoctoral Fellows who present their research at national or international scientific meetings.

#### **Award Details**

One award will be given per year, to a maximum of \$1,500.

This award is open to Postdoctoral Fellows (PDFs) who are/were engaged in <u>training positions</u> supervised by a faculty member from the Department of Laboratory Medicine & Pathobiology (LMP) at the time of travel for the meeting. Research staff (such as technicians or research associates) are not eligible.

#### **How to Apply**

Submit a completed application form, along with supporting documents to the LMP Graduate Office (MS 6209 or email <a href="mailto:lmp.grad@utoronto.ca">lmp.grad@utoronto.ca</a> on or before the deadline.

#### **Deadline**

12:00pm, Wednesday May 29, 2019

#### **Applicant Eligibility**

- 1. Applicants must have received their PhD degree (or equivalent) no earlier than three years prior to the date of travel to the conference.
- 2. Applicants may only apply for travel to conferences at which the research presented was conducted while engaged as a PDF at LMP. The travel award may not be used to support presentations based on work done at another university or hospital centre prior to or after being engaged at LMP. Where a presentation results from work related to a current, recognized, collaborative venture between groups in the Department of Laboratory Medicine & Pathobiology or an affiliated hospital and a second institution, an application for this award may be considered.
- 3. If the applicant's engagement is not registered through the School of Graduate Studies, a copy of the engagement contract may be requested as a supplement to the application.

#### **Conference Eligibility**

- 1. Applicants must have given a poster or platform presentation at a national or international meeting that occurred or will occur between January 1, 2019 and June 30, 2019. The applicant must be either first or co-first author on the research presented.
- 2. To be eligible for support, presentations (and abstracts) must clearly acknowledge the Department of Laboratory Medicine & Pathobiology, University of Toronto, and relevant hospital/research centre, if applicable.

#### **Notes**

Applicants may only submit one application per competition, for travel to one conference.
